The Jobs and Skills Centre provides holistic, on-site career services to Roebourne District High School students in years 10-12, working one on one, or in groups to support students in entering the workforce.

## HOW CAN THE JOBS & SKILLS CENTRE ASSIST?

We are able to provide individual and group support to students with:

- Identifying students interests and abilities
- Addressing barriers that may hinder gainful employment
- Assist students with their understanding of employer requirements and expectations.
- Assist students with resumes' and the job application process.

We also work to support Employers through the recruitment process by providing; recruitment assistance, advertising opportunities on Aboriginal specific jobs boards, apprentice/trainee recruitment information, workforce development advice resources and provide advice on Aboriginal recruitment and retention strategies.
